The Neonatal Neurology Clinic is a specialized program that began in 2006 and is designed to support brain health and development in newborns who have unique neurological needs. The program provides comprehensive, multidisciplinary services for patients and their families who are diagnosed with a brain injury or are at risk of developmental challenges.

Our goal is to provide the best possible care for our patients from birth through long-term follow up. According to Jennifer Armstrong, MD, MPH, FAHA, pediatric neurologist, and director of the Neonatal Neurology Program, babies who are at risk of developmental problems and get therapies or other services earlier tend to do better. By the time children show symptoms like only using one hand or always walking on their tiptoes, it is more difficult to overcome these challenges.

“It is our job to make sure your child is getting everything they need,” says Dr. Armstrong. Our team is committed to innovative research including studies in preterm birth, hypoxic ischemic encephalopathy (HIE), and neurodevelopment.
